*Strep pneumoniae Of 22 isolates in 2019, 90% were ceftriaxone susceptible and 100% levofloxacin susceptible.

*Enterococcal species Of 34 enterococcal bacteremias in 2019, 27 were due to Enterococcus faecalis and 7 were due to Enterococcus faecium. 100% of the Enterococcus faecalis isolates were sensitive to ampicillin. 71% of the Enterococcus faecium isolates were vancomycin resistant (VRE). Of the VRE isolates, none were linezolid or daptomycin resistant.
